Work duties primarily include urban focused forestry and wildfire/flood management project work. Our DTA/DTFs also work as Wildland Fire Fighters and/or Crew Leaders (experience pending) in addition to DTA/DTF work. Our employees typically live within a 2-hour driving radius of Coldstream, BC. Successful candidates will work remotely and be required to travel throughout the BC Interior.

- Able to fly in fixed wing and rotary aircraft
